## TOBACCO DIRECTORY UPDATE NOTIFICATION DECEMBER 16, 2014

Below is a summary of directory updates published on December 16, 2014.

### [Directory of Fire Standards Compliant Manufacturers](#)

- The manufacturer NASCO Products LLC and four (4) brand varieties of cigarettes were newly certified as FSC compliant, including two (2) brand varieties of Red Sun brand cigarettes and two (2) brand varieties of Magic brand cigarettes. In addition, eleven (11) brand varieties of SF brand cigarettes were recertified and transferred from Commonwealth Brands, Inc. to NASCO Products LLC.
- For the manufacturer Alternative Brands, Inc., ten (10) brand varieties of Tracker brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.
- For the manufacturer Belcorp of America, Inc. d/b/a Phoenix Industria E Comercio De Tabacos, Ltda., thirty-five brand varieties of cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant, including nine (9) brand varieties of Derby brand cigarettes, seventeen (17) brand varieties of First One brand cigarettes, and nine (9) brand varieties of Rich brand cigarettes.
- For the manufacturer General Jack's Incorporated, ten (10) brand varieties of Worth brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.
- For the manufacturer Heritage Tobacco LLC, six (6) brand varieties of Hobby Premium brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.
- For the manufacturer Smokin Joes, nine (9) brand varieties of New York New York brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.

Please be advised that all cigarettes sold or offered for sale in Kansas must comply with the Fire Safety Standard and Firefighter Protection Act, K.S.A. 31-601 *et seq.*, and the Requirements for Sale of Cigarettes Act, K.S.A. 50-6a01 *et seq.* Accordingly, the Directory of Fire Standards Compliant Manufacturers *must* be read in conjunction with the Directory of Compliant Non-Participating Manufacturers and the Directory of Compliant Participating Manufacturers in order to determine which cigarettes are legal for sale in Kansas.
