**TOBACCO DIRECTORY  
UPDATE NOTIFICATION  
JULY 30, 2015**

Below is a summary of directory updates published on July 30, 2015.

## [Directory of Fire Standards Compliant Manufacturers](#)

- The manufacturer Cheyenne International LLC recertified twenty-five (25) brand varieties as FSC compliant, including four (4) brand varieties of Aura brand cigarettes, eleven (11) brand varieties of Cheyenne brand cigarettes, and ten (10) brand varieties of Decade brand cigarettes.
- The manufacturer Grand River Enterprises Six Nations Ltd. recertified forty-five (45) brand varieties as FSC compliant, including six (6) brand varieties of Couture brand cigarettes, five (5) brand varieties of Opal brand cigarettes, and thirty-four (34) brand varieties of Seneca brand cigarettes.
- The manufacturer King Maker Marketing Inc. recertified twenty-eight (28) brand varieties as FSC compliant, including seven (7) brand varieties of Ace brand cigarettes, seven (7) brand varieties of Checkers brand cigarettes, seven (7) brand varieties of Gold Crest brand cigarettes, and seven (7) brand varieties of Hi-Val brand cigarettes.
- The manufacturer Liggett Group LLC recertified sixty-three (63) brand varieties as FSC compliant, including thirteen (13) brand varieties of Bronson brand cigarettes, four (4) brand varieties of Eve brand cigarettes, thirteen (13) brand varieties of Grand Prix brand cigarettes, fourteen (14) brand varieties of Liggett Select brand cigarettes, eight (8) brand varieties of Montego brand cigarettes, and eleven (11) brand varieties of Pyramid brand cigarettes. In addition, eight (8) brand varieties of Bronson brand cigarettes, three (3) brand varieties of Grand Prix brand cigarettes, three (3) brand varieties of Liggett Select brand cigarettes, and one (1) brand variety of Pyramid brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.
- The manufacturer Premier Manufacturing recertified twenty-eight (28) brand varieties as FSC compliant, including ten (10) brand varieties of 1839 brand cigarettes, nine (9) brand varieties of Shield brand cigarettes, and nine (9) brand varieties of Wildhorse brand cigarettes. In addition, one (1) brand variety of 1839 brand cigarettes, one (1) brand variety of Shield brand cigarettes, and one (1) brand variety of Wildhorse brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.
- The manufacturer Vector Tobacco Inc. recertified fourteen (14) brand varieties of USA brand cigarettes as FSC compliant. In addition, two (2) brand varieties of USA brand cigarettes and twelve (12) brand varieties of Eagle 20's brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.

Please be advised that all cigarettes sold or offered for sale in Kansas must comply with the Fire Safety Standard and Firefighter Protection Act, K.S.A. 31-601 *et seq.*, and the Requirements for Sale of Cigarettes Act, K.S.A. 50-6a01 *et seq.* Accordingly, the Directory of Fire Standards Compliant Manufacturers *must* be read in conjunction with the Directory of Compliant Non-Participating Manufacturers and the Directory of Compliant Participating Manufacturers in order to determine which cigarettes are legal for sale in Kansas.
