Please be advised that all cigarettes sold or offered for sale in Kansas must comply with the Fire Safety Standard and Firefighter Protection Act (K.S.A. 31-601 *et seq.*) and rules and regulations adopted thereto. In addition, all cigarettes must also comply with the Requirements for Sale of Cigarettes Act (K.S.A. 50-6a01 *et seq.*). Therefore, to determine which cigarettes are legal for sale in Kansas, the Directory of Fire Standards Compliant Manufacturers must be read in conjunction with the Directory of Compliant Non-Participating Manufacturers and Directory of Compliant Participating Manufacturers.
