**JOURNAL ENTRY**

NOW on this 12th day of June, 1996, the above-entitled matter comes on for hearing. The plaintiff, State of Kansas, *ex rel.*, Carla J. Stovall, Attorney General, appears by and through Robert E. Hiatt and James J. Welch, Assistant Attorneys General. The defendant appears by and through John A. Reynolds, Attorney at Law.

Whereupon after receiving the evidence and statements of counsel, the Court enters the following orders:

- 1) Defendant, Jarold W. Johnson, is sentenced to six months in jail beginning this date

for multiple violations of the Court Order of December 5, 1995, holding him in contempt.

2) The Court orders the defendant to serve three consecutive weeks with release scheduled for three weeks from this date. If the defendant does not do any other waterproofing for two years, the Court will not impose the additional five months upon him. If he does any more waterproofing, he will be required to complete the remaining time.

3) The defendant, Jarold W. Johnson, is ordered to pay \$10,000.00 to the Consumer Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General for consumer reimbursement.

4) Attorney fees in the amount of \$1,500.00 and court costs of approximately \$325.00 are ordered to be paid by the defendant within a reasonable period of time.

5) The court orders defendant, Jarold W. Johnson, to allow the Attorney General's office complete access to all properties owned or rented by Jarold W. Johnson to search for assets to be used to reimburse consumers.

6) The defendant, Jarold W. Johnson, is ordered to discontinue the use of all post office boxes, 1-800 telephone numbers and advertisements for basement waterproofing.


7) The defendant, Jarold W. Johnson, is ordered never to participate in any waterproofing business under his name or under any assumed names.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the above findings are hereby made the order of the court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




