

INTRODUCTION

The Kansas Crime Victims Compensation Board completed its thirteenth year of operation June 30, 1991. The Kansas Legislature, in 1978, established the Board, (formerly the Crime Victims Reparations Board) pursuant to K.S.A. 74-7301, et seq. recognizing that innocent victims of crime have been overlooked by the criminal justice system. In answer to the directive of the Legislature, the Crime Victims Compensation Board during its existence (July 1, 1978 - June 30, 1991) has made awards to 3,046 victims in Kansas for out-of-pocket medical expenses, loss of earnings or support, burial expenses and other costs associated with the treatment of their injuries, sustained as a result of being a victim of a violent crime. In its thirteen years of operation the Crime Victims Compensation Board has awarded a total of \$7,072,621 for payment of these losses because it was the last resort for the injured, innocent victim.

I. GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Crime Victims Compensation Board is appointed by the Attorney General and consists of three members: C. William Ossmann, Topeka, Chair; Dorthy S. Miller, Pittsburg, and Carlos Cooper, Kansas City. There are five staff members: the Executive Director, two Investigators, a Secretary and a Keyboard Operator II.

The Crime Victims Compensation Board provides funds to victims of criminally injurious conduct, or their dependents in cases of death, in the payment of medical care, rehabilitation, rehabilitative occupational training and other treatment and care if it is determined by the Board, after thorough investigation that: (1) the victim did not provoke the incident on which the claim is based; (2) the incident occurred in Kansas or a Kansas resident who was injured in a state who does not have an eligible compensation program; (3) the incident was reported to the proper law enforcement agency within 72 hours; (4) the application for

compensation was filed within one year of the incident, or in the case of indecent liberties, one year from date incident was reported to law enforcement; (5) the victim was not an accomplice to the incident; (6) economic loss totals more than \$100 and has not been recouped from other sources including collateral sources.

Work loss and dependent economic loss are limited to \$200 per week; expenses in any way related to funeral, cremation or burial are limited to \$2,000. Compensation payable to a victim or dependent may not exceed \$25,000. It is incumbent on the Board to verify that all information contained in the application is true and that the amounts requested are the responsibility of the claimant and a direct result of the incident on which the claim is based.

The Crime Victims Compensation Board had 977 claims filed in FY 91, compared to 980 claims filed during FY 90. The average award per claim has fluctuated somewhat; the ratio of awards paid to claims filed has remained fairly constant at nearly 60%. Attorney fees, as specified by statute, are paid only for assistance provided to the victim in preparation of the claim at the rate of \$45 per hour and are awarded in addition to the victim/claimant award.

Attorney General Stephan provides leadership to the Executive Director of the Crime Victims Compensation Board and the Victims' Rights Statewide Coordinator. They work together to assure that victims are advised of their rights under the Victims' Rights legislation passed during the 1989 Legislative Session. A statewide Victims' Rights Hotline (1-800-828-9745) was established, and a closer liaison developed with law enforcement agencies, rape crisis centers, victim/witness programs and domestic violence programs. These initiatives were undertaken to enhance the awareness of the Crime Victims Compensation Program.

In 1982 the Legislature assigned administration of the Rape Prevention and Crisis Intervention Services portion of the Federal Preventative Health and Health Services Block Grant to the Crime Victims Compensation Board. The Crime Victims Compensation Board had \$34,900 available during FY 91. A total of \$34,900 was disbursed to local programs, statewide. The funds were used for continuation of sexual assault prevention programs for children and adults and to create or maintain rape crisis intervention hotlines. Fifteen programs received grants from this fund. (See Page 11).

In 1984, the Legislature established the Protection From Abuse Fund (K.S.A. 74-7325) for the purpose of creating funds for programs providing services to victims of domestic abuse. The funding was established in K.S.A. 23-108a to provide an \$8 fee assessment added to marriage license fees received in each county throughout the state. In 1989, this provision was amended, raising the marriage license fee assessment to \$23. Monies deposited in the Protection From Abuse Fund are administered by the Crime Victims Compensation Board in the form of grants-in-aid.

In FY 91, a total of \$659,263 was available in the Protection From Abuse Fund and a total of \$467,828 was disbursed to domestic abuse programs statewide. The funds were used to assist funding the administration and operation of direct services within domestic abuse programs and consisted of the following:

- (a) 24-hour crisis intervention;
- (b) shelter or safehouse facilities;
- (c) assistance and referral for victims; and
- (d) emergency transportation.

Twenty-two programs received grants from this fund in FY 91. (See Page 10). In June 1986 the Crime Victims Compensation Board applied for and received a grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services under the Family Protection From Abuse Fund. \$65,477 was awarded during FY 91 as supplemental awards to fifteen domestic violence program.

II. FUNDING OF COMPENSATION PROGRAM

Prior to FY 83, the Crime Victims Compensation Board was solely funded by the State General Fund. During the 1982 Legislative session legislation was passed allowing the Crime Victims Compensation Board to receive an assessment of \$1 from each criminal court docket fee collected. The money received was to be deposited in the Crime Victims Compensation Fund and used solely for payment of compensation to victims. In order to meet the growing number of claims the 1985 Legislature increased to \$2 the court docket assessment earmarked for compensation.

The FY 89 Legislature, recognizing the inadequacy of the Crime Victims Compensation funding altered the funding source for compensation by deleting the deposit of \$2 of the criminal court docket fee and in its stead required the deposit of 19% of all fines, penalties and forfeitures received by each clerk of the district court of each county deposited into the Crime Victims Compensation Fund. The change of funding source increased the Crime Victims Compensation Fund to \$1,911,956. This funding insures that victims of violent crimes will be expeditiously reimbursed for their losses. The funding further allows all administrative costs to be borne by the Crime Victims Compensation Fund, thus ensuring that all monies received from the Protection From Abuse Fund and the Federal Programs are granted to the various domestic violence and rape crisis programs previously referred to in this report. In FY 1986 the Crime Victims Compensation Board applied for and received, under the Victims of Crime Act of 1984, federal funds to be used for payment of compensation. A total of \$716,000 has been received to date, \$146,000 of which was utilized during FY 91 for payment of compensation claims.

III. THE APPLICATION FOR COMPENSATION

The office receives numerous inquiries about eligibility for compensation. Some inquiries, however, are not processed by opening a file because it can be determined that the

victim was not eligible under the statute. Many of the ineligible inquiries concern automobile and property crimes which are excluded by the statute.

If the claim meets the eligibility requirements it is necessary to:

- (1) obtain a description of the incident from law enforcement reports to determine if any provocation by the victim is indicated and, if so, to contact any witnesses to the incident for their statements;
- (2) request any additional documentation which the claimant did not attach;
- (3) check with the respective District or County Attorney's office to determine if proceedings against the offender are imminent and, if so, to ask that restitution be considered at the time of sentencing;
- (4) verify the victim's relationship, if any, to the alleged offender;
- (5) consider other collateral sources reported as received by the claimant as a result of the incident; for example, Social Security, Worker's Compensation, private insurance, etc.
- (6) verify employment of the victim and/or the claimant in cases of wage loss or dependent economic loss;
- (7) verify the outstanding balances of hospital and doctor bills and their relevance to the claim; and
- (8) conduct a personal interview with the claimant regarding the information contained in the claim and the involvement of the claimant in the circumstances surrounding the incident.

A synopsis of all claims to be considered is forwarded to the three Board Members in ample time for them to review the claims prior to the board meetings. Board meetings

are generally held on the second Friday of each month. The Board, after review of the claims and discussion, renders its decision and the claimants are notified within seven days, with a right of appeal.

The Board is subrogated to the cause of the action of the applicant against the person responsible for the injury or death of the victim and also against the offender for the amount of damages sustained by the applicant.

IV. STATUTORY HISTORY

The Crime Victims Compensation Board (K.S.A. 74-7301-7318) was established by the Legislature in 1978 to alleviate the financial hardships caused by crime-related medical expenses and loss of income sustained by victims of violent crimes in Kansas. The statute also provides that some payment can be made to dependents of deceased victims. The Legislature, H.B. 3004, amended K.S.A. 74-7305(2)(g) which allowed rape victims to be awarded compensation even though their economic loss would be less than \$100.

K.S.A. 1984 Supp. 74-7325 established the Protection From Abuse Fund for the purpose of creating funds for programs providing services to victims of domestic abuse. The funding source established in this legislation was an \$8 fee assessment added to marriage liscense fees received in each county throughout the state. The 1989 Legislature increased the fee assessment to \$23. These monies are deposited in the Protection from Abuse Fund and are administered by the Crime Victims Compensation Board in the form of grants-in-aid.

K.S.A. 1984 Supp. 20-362 was revised by the 1985 Legislature with S.B. 108 which increased to \$2 a fee assessment collected from the cost of each docket fee of a criminal proceeding in any county. This money was deposited in the Crime Victims Reparations Fund Established by the original docket fee assessment legislation by the 982 Legislature, H.B. 3005.

- K.S.A. 74-7302 was amended by the 1985 Legislature, S.B. 344 to read as follows: "Within the limits of appropriations therefor, the board shall award compensation for economic loss arising from criminally injurious conduct if satisfied by a preponderance of the evidence that the requirements for reparations have been met." The legislative intent of this amendment was to further clarify that the Crime Victims Compensation Board is not an entitlement program.
- S.B. 685 passed by the 1986 Legislature amended K.S.A. 74-7317 to allow moneys in the Crime Victims Reparations Fund to be used for state operations of the Board eliminating the commitment of the State General Fund. S.B. 685 also amended 74-7312 to allow moneys recovered by the Crime Victims Reparations Board through subrogation to be deposited in to the Crime Victims Compensation Fund rather than the State General Fund.
- S.B. 700 passed by the 1986 Legislature amended K.S.A. 74-7301(e) allowing victims of motor vehicle incidents involving DUI to be eligible to receive compensation for uninsured losses under the same restrictions and limitations imposed on victims of violent crimes. S.B. 700 also added New Section 2 to K.S.A. 74-7301 (74-7319) which requires that any profits from the sale of books, magazines, or other publications or from any movie, radio, television presentation or live entertainment regarding criminally accused or convicted person's (or their assignee's) thoughts, feelings, opinion, or emotions regarding the crime shall be paid to the Crime Victims Compensation Board.

Any moneys received are to be deposited into an escrow account until distribution of funds can be determined. K.S.A. 74-7301 was amended by the 1986 Legislature, S.B. 567, which provides specific language allowing the Crime Victims Compensation Board to apply for, receive and accept money from any source, including financial contributions from inmate workers wages thus allowing the State of Kansas to meet a mandatory certification requirement to participate in the Private Sector/Prison Industry Enhancement (PIE) Program administered by the Bureau of Justice Assistance of the U.S. Department of Justice.

The 1989 Legislature in H.B. 2200 substantially amended the Crime Victims Compensation statute as follows: (a) the name of the Board was changed to Crime Victims Compensation Board; (b) the Board was transferred to the Office of the Attorney General; (c) maximum allowed for funeral expense was raised to \$2,000; (d) the maximum amount allowable per claim was raised to \$25,000; (e) the financial means test was deleted; (f) eligibility for compensation was amended to include Kansas residents victimized in states without an eligible compensation program; (g) funding of the Crime Victims Compensation program was changed from reliance on the criminal docket fee to 19% of all fines, penalties and forfeitures collected by the clerk of the district court in each county.

The 1990 Legislature in S.B. 674, amended the Crime Victims Compensation statute, K.S.A. 74-7305(b) by deleting that section which required that the offender could not live in the same household as the victim. This legislation was required by federal guidelines to insure that Kansas retain its eligibility for federal Victims of Crime funds. The Legislature further passed enabling legislation to allow counties to establish property crime compensation boards.

In 1991, the Legislature in HB 2374 amended the Crime Victims Compensation Statute KSA-74-7305(h) to provide, "Compensation may not be awarded unless an application has been filed with the Board within one year of the reporting of the incident to law enforcement officials if the victim was less than 16 years of age and their injury or death is the result of any of the following crimes; (1) Indecent liberties with a child as defined in KSA 21-3503..." This amendment acknowledges that the children are not forthcoming as to their victimization.





Age Distribution Of Victims




Crime Type By Percentage 1991

SUMMARY OF ILLUSTRATIVE CASES

12766-90 & 12767-90

These brothers, ages 7 and 11, were the victims of Indecent Liberties by their uncle, who had recently been released from prison for a similar offense. He was charged and convicted of these offenses against his nephews. The Board approved counseling expenses of \$360.00 for each child.

13573-91

Having a love for the sport basketball was why Mr. T took his refereeing job seriously. While refereeing a very intense game, Mr. T made a decision to call the game. One player not liking the call made by Mr. T started to shout profanities at Mr. T. Mr. T asked the player to leave the gym. The player became more angry and grabbed Mr. T, struck him repeatedly until he collapsed to the floor. The player left immediately, and a warrant was issued for his arrest. The CVCB assisted Mr. T with medical bills and wage loss totaling \$5,861.29.

12837-90

The son of this 50 year old victim applied on his deceased father's behalf. His father was killed in an automobile incident. The other vehicle ran a red light and the driver was charged with vehicular homicide. Because the charges did not include Aggravated Battery or DUI, the Board had to deny the claim.

130297-91

This two year old was excited every morning when he went to the baby-sitter's house. The baby-sitter had a full-blooded dog named Muffin whom he loved to help feed and pet. One morning while the two year old was helping the baby-sitter feed Muffin, Muffin came charging at him, dragging him some distance and biting him in the face. The baby-sitter was charged and convicted of endangerment of a child. The Board approved medical expenses for plastic surgery and scar revision just over \$1,000.00 to date.

12868-90

This 25 year old woman was at home with her brother and a group of friends. They had all been drinking and a fight broke out between her brother and another individual. It escalated into several people becoming involved, including this woman. After careful review of the police report, the Board concluded that while the woman claimed she was coming to the rescue of her brother, she voluntarily entered the melee and they reduced her award by 50%. Wage loss and medical expenses totaling \$1,347.63 were approved.

13295-91

Inside the yellow painted home on the east side of town lay 61 year old Ms. B, who had been beaten by her neighbor, a fifteen year old girl who had come to visit Ms. B. While visiting, Ms. B thought there was something different about her. She was acting like a maniac, started calling Ms. B bad names, and proceeded to push Ms. B from behind causing her to fall and break her hip, arm, and leg. Ms. B yelled for help and was eventually found by another neighbor. The offender was placed on

probation. The CVCB assisted with medical bills totaling \$1,740.32.

130076-91

This woman applied on behalf of her 26 year old son who was shot to death. Although the defendant was convicted of 2nd Degree Murder, the Board determined that this shooting was the direct result of an illegal drug sale. They denied the claim for contributory misconduct.

13338-91

After leaving the Plaza Club, Mr. Z was walking to his car in the parking lot when he was approached by a friend who told him he had been beaten by a male person. Mr. Z decided to go with his friend to confront the male who had beaten him. While Mr. Z exchanged a few fighting words with this male, another friend of Mr. Z stepped between and said she didn't want any fights. The same male stepped up and punched her out and took off running. Mr. Z started to chase him with another friend when his friend hit Mr. Z in the head with a pipe and broke his jaw in two places. Mr. Z applied to CVCB for medical expenses totaling \$9,170.46 His claim was reduced by 50% due to Contributory Misconduct. Mr. Z appealed his case. The CVCB, after reviewing his case a second time, reaffirmed their first decision.

130272-91

This 25 year old man was the victim of a Battery. There was insurance coverage, however, and because his out-of-pocket expenses were less than the statutory minimum of \$100.00, the Board denied the claim.

13493-91 & 13560-91

Ms. G applied to CVCB for Dependent Economic Loss and funeral expenses on behalf of her husband who was the victim of a fatal shooting. Two weeks later, the CVCB received another application on behalf of the same victim from a different claimant who claimed to be the victim's wife. After a complete investigation and careful review of both applications, the CVCB denied Ms. G's claim for Dependent Economic Loss. The Board accepted the second application and awarded \$11,000 for Dependent Economic Loss and reimbursed Ms. G for Out of Pocket funeral expenses. Total award was \$13,000.00.

130480-91

This 27 year old woman was alone at work at a small liquor store when she was raped and sodomized by a man posing as a customer. He cut the phone cord and taped her hands behind her back. He fled on foot and she was able to free herself and go for help. The perpetrator has never been identified or charged. Counseling expenses, including in-hospital treatment, in the amount of \$1,246.89, was approved. Insurance had covered the greater amount.

130440-91 & 130463-91

This woman applied on behalf of her 11 year old son who was shot and killed by his father in the presence of the couple's 5 year old daughter. The father was despondent over an impending divorce. He was subsequently convicted of First Degree Murder. The Board approved counseling expenses for the mother and daughter totaling \$856.86.
