

**Reporting and Replacing**  
**Lost or Destroyed Kansas Concealed Carry License**

K.S.A. 75-7c06 (f); In the event that a concealed handgun license is lost or destroyed, the license shall be automatically invalid, and the person to whom the license was issued, upon payment of \$15 to the attorney general, may obtain a duplicate, or substitute thereof, upon furnishing a notarized statement to the attorney general that such license has been lost or destroyed. (Make check payable to the "Office of the Attorney General.")

Mail the notarized statement and \$15.00 fee to the **Office of Attorney General, Concealed Carry Licensing Unit, 120 SW 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Topeka, KS 66612-1597**. A notice of approval to reissue the license will be mailed to the licensee. The notice of approval must be taken to a full-service driver's license station for issuance. The driver's license station will charge an additional fee to process the new license card. If the licensee's address has changed, it should be noted on a separate sheet of paper and submitted with this form.
