TOBACCO DIRECTORY UPDATE NOTIFICATION DECEMBER 28, 2015

Below is a summary of directory updates published on December 28, 2015.

[Directory of Fire Standards Compliant Manufacturers](#)

- For the manufacturer Alternative Brands Inc., twenty-six (26) brand varieties of cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant, including eleven (11) brand varieties of Tracker brand cigarettes and fifteen (15) brand varieties of Tucson brand cigarettes.
- The manufacturer Commonwealth Brands Inc. certified fifty-two (52) brand varieties, including eleven (11) brand varieties of Fortuna brand cigarettes, four (4) brand varieties of Montclair brand cigarettes, fourteen (14) brand varieties of Sonoma brand cigarettes, and twenty-three (23) brand varieties of USA Gold brand cigarettes. In addition, six (6) brand varieties of Davidoff brand cigarettes, three (3) brand varieties of Gauloises brand cigarettes, two (2) brand varieties of Gitanes brand cigarettes, six (6) brand varieties of Montclair brand cigarettes, and three (3) brands of USA Gold brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.
- For the manufacturer Compania Tabacalera Internacional, S.A., eight (8) brand varieties of Director brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.
- For the manufacturer Japan Tobacco International USA, Inc., five (5) brand varieties of Export 'A' brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.
- The manufacturer KT&G Corporation recertified fifteen (15) brand varieties of Carnival brand cigarettes as FSC compliant.
- For the manufacturer Tantus Tobacco LLC, eight (8) brand varieties of 24/7 brand cigarettes were removed and are no longer FSC compliant.

Please be advised that all cigarettes sold or offered for sale in Kansas must comply with the Fire Safety Standard and Firefighter Protection Act, K.S.A. 31-601 *et seq.*, and the Requirements for Sale of Cigarettes Act, K.S.A. 50-6a01 *et seq.* Accordingly, the Directory of Fire Standards Compliant Manufacturers *must* be read in conjunction with the Directory of Compliant Non-Participating Manufacturers and the Directory of Compliant Participating Manufacturers in order to determine which cigarettes are legal for sale in Kansas.
