As required by K.S.A. 74-7316, the Crime Victims Reparations Board has prepared the following annual report covering the period from July 1, 1983 to June 30, 1984.

I. PROGRAM INFORMATION

K.S.A. 74-7301 - 7318, establishing a Crime Victims Reparations Board was adopted by the 1978 Legislature, and became effective July 1, 1978. The statute was passed to provide victims of violent crime compensation for loss of earnings and out-of-pocket loss for injuries sustained as a direct result of a crime committed against their person. Out-of-pocket loss is defined as reasonable medical care, counseling, or other care necessary as a result of the injury. The statute provides a maximum payment of \$10,000, including a \$750 maximum award for funeral expenses. Any collateral source receipts, which are defined as medical insurance, Social Security, Worker's Compensation, and Unemployment Compensation, are deducted from any award the Board allows.

In 1982 the Legislature assigned administration of the Rape Prevention and Crisis Intervention Services portion of the federal Preventive Health and Health Services Block Grant to the Crime Victims Reparations Board. The Crime Victims Reparations Board has received \$30,816 each fiscal year since FY 1983.

In FY 1984, due to carryover funds available from the prior fiscal year, a total of \$48,297.25 was granted to local programs, statewide. The funds were used to establish sexual assault prevention programs for children and adults and to create or maintain rape crisis intervention hotlines. Thirteen programs received grants from this fund. (See Table 3)

The Crime Victims Reparations Board is appointed by the Governor and consists of three members: Michael Glover, Chairperson; Alma Sanford Carter, Member; and LaTelletta D. Lipscomb, Member.

There are three fulltime staff: the Executive Director, an Investigator, and a Secretary.

II. THE APPLICATION PROCESS

The office receives numerous inquiries about eligibility for reparations. However, some inquiries are not processed by opening a file because it can be determined that the victim was not eligible under the statute. Many of ineligible inquiries concern automobile and property crimes which are excluded by the statute.

Upon receipt of a Declaration of Eligibility and Application, it is necessary to determine minimal eligibility. Therefore, compliance with the following statutory requirements must be in evidence before processing the application:

- 1) The crime was committed in Kansas.
- 2) The crime was reported to proper authorities within seventy-two hours.

3) The claim was filed within the one year limit set by law.

If the claim does not meet the above standards, it is determined to be ineligible and the claimant is notified.

If the claim meets these initial tests, it is necessary to:

- 1) acknowledge receipt of the Declaration of Eligibility and forward an Application and Authorization form for them to sign and return. The authorization is necessary so that the Board has access to medical, hospital and employment records material to the claim;
- 2) obtain a description of the incident from law enforcement reports to determine if any provocation by the victim is indicated and, if so, to contact any witnesses to the incident for their statements;
- 3) acknowledge receipt of the claim and request any additional documentation which the claimant did not attach;
- 4) check with the respective District or County Attorney's office to determine if proceedings against the offender are eminent and if so to ask that restitution may be considered at the time of sentencing;
- 5) verify the victim's relationship, if any, to the alleged offender;
- 6) consider other collateral sources reported as received by the claimant as a result of the incident; for example, Social Security, Worker's Compensation, private insurance, etc.

Upon receipt of the requested information, further investigation is necessary to verify:

- 1) the employment of the victim and/or the claimant;
- 2) the income reported and documentation, if the victim is/was self-employed;
- 3) the outstanding balances of hospital and doctor bills and their relevance to the claim; and
- 4) conduct a personal interview with the claimant regarding the information contained in the claim, and the involvement of the claimant in the circumstances surrounding the incident.

When the claim is complete, the file is copied and submitted to the Board for their review and determination. They, in turn, may:

- a) find the claim cannot be determined due to lack of documentation or information which the Board feels necessary to make a decision;
- b) find a claim eligible under the statute for the award requested and advise a warrant be issued;
- c) find a claim eligible under the statute for a lesser amount than requested and advise that the claimant be so notified indicating that a hearing may be requested;
- d) find the claim cannot be determined due to conflicting data therein and advise a hearing is required prior to a final decision; or
- e) find the claim ineligible under the statutes and advise that the claimant be so notified indicating that a hearing may be requested.

The Staff carries out the Board's decisions by:

- a) making additional contacts in order to obtain further documentation;
- b) writing a letter to the claimant enclosing the Decision and Order and the Assignments, requesting the claimant to execute the documents, noting the claimant's right to request a hearing in the event the award is less than was requested by the claimant;
- c) requesting warrants, if an award is determined and after a signed consent has been received;
- d) scheduling a hearing if the Board finds conflicting data in a claim or is in doubt about any part of the claim;
- e) notifying the claimant, by letter, if the claim is denied stating the reason for denial and advising the claimant of the opportunity to request a hearing. The request for a hearing is to be received in the Board office within thirty days after date of notification.

In order to schedule a hearing, all parties are notified of the date and location fifteen days prior to the date set. The Board sits as the hearing officer and renders its decision as expeditiously as possible pending request for additional data.

The Board is subrogated to the cause of the action of the applicant against the person responsible for the injury or death of the victim and also against the offender for the amount of damages sustained by the applicant.

III. STATISTICAL ANALYSIS

The Crime Victims Reparations Board has experienced a dramatic increase in claim filings every year since FY 1982. Claim filings have increased almost 30% each year, and while the average award per claim has fluctuated somewhat, the ratio of claims filed to awards paid has remained fairly constant at nearly 60%. The number of \$10,000 awards, the maximum payment allowed by statute, increased from seven awards in FY 1983 to nine awards in FY 1984. Attorneys fees, as specified by statute, are paid only for assistance provided to the victim in preparation of a claim at the rate of \$30 per hour.

It is important to note that the increase described above has occurred in the absence of any systematic information dissemination to publicize the reparations program. One explanation of this phenomena is that increased awareness among victims and service providers has expanded the public information network, resulting in more claim filings. When this report went to press, an increase in claim filings of 30% over FY 1984 had already been recorded for the first five months of FY 1985, in addition to a 150% increase in the number of \$10,000 claim awards, during the same period. Due to increasing awareness among law enforcement agencies, domestic violence programs who serve many victims eligible for reparations, and the public in general, a continued increase is projected.
