	3) Professionals and media tell "stories" about suicide regarding things like bullying or social media due to lack of good science. We feel like we need a "magic solution" instead of looking for true causes through research.

Recommendations or suggestions for the task force to consider:	 Increased support of crisis centers (Headquarters Counseling Center for KS) (60% increase in calls during 2018)
	 Involve youth, parents, and schools in gatekeeper training (with solid evidence-base; it's not sufficient to just raise awareness).
	3) Increased and consistent education of administration leadership, school mental health professionals, parents, all school staff (Suicide in Schools)
	4) Improve State data pipelines and communications about state suicide and youth suicide data. (Data on attempts, deaths, ideation, etc.)
	5) Once data is collected, provide said data and fund outcomes-based research based on it. World class researchers, many AAS members, are eager to access data.
	6) Updated State Strategy
	7) Fund full-time Suicide Prevention Coordinator (to help collect data - faster than CDC - and target implementation; Montana as example)
	8) Standardized state-wide psych autopsies
