ORDER OF DEFAULT JUDGMENT

NOW, on this 8th day of July, 2011, Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment against Defendants comes before this Court for consideration. The State of Kansas, *ex rel.* Derek Schmidt, appears by and through Assistant Attorney General, Meghan E. Stoppel. Defendants appear not.

WHEREUPON, after reviewing the Court's file and Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment, the Court finds the following:

1. Plaintiff filed its Motion for Default Judgment against Defendants and Memorandum in Support on June 7, 2011.

2. Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment is predicated upon Defendants failure to file an Answer to Plaintiff's Petition which was filed on April 12, 2011.

3. A copy of the Summons and the original Petition were served upon Defendant Williams Law Center PC, care of Registered Agent Jennifer Y. Williams at 25391 Commercentre Drive #250, Lake Forest, California 92630 on April 27, 2011, pursuant to K.S.A. §60-304(e) and §60-303(c).

4. A copy of the Summons and the original Petition were served upon Defendant A.I.M. Center, LLC, care of Registered Agent Gregory Post at 700 Garden View Court, Encinitas, California 92024, on April 18, 2011, pursuant to K.S.A. §60-304(a) and §60-303(c).

5. Defendants failed to file an Answer within thirty days after being served with process, as required by K.S.A. §60-308(a)(3).

6. Pursuant to K.S.A. §60-255, Defendants are in default.

7. The legal arguments and authorities set forth in Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment against Defendants and Memorandum in Support are adopted by the Court as its findings of fact and conclusions of law as though fully set forth herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDICATED AND DECREED Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDICATED AND DECREED that judgment is hereby entered against Defendants, in favor of Plaintiff on all counts of the Petition.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDICATED AND DECREED that the alleged violations of the Kansas Consumer Protection Act are declared to be deceptive and unconscionable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDICATED AND DECREED that Defendants and Defendants' employees and agents be permanently enjoined from engaging in the acts alleged in Plaintiff's Petition to be violations of the Kansas Consumer Protection Act.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDICATED AND DECREED that Defendants pay restitution to Bobby and Nancy Starling in the amount of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight dollars (\$1,868.00).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDICATED AND DECREED that Defendants be restrained from advertising, soliciting and selling any services, goods or property in Kansas until such time that full restitution is made to Bobby and Nancy Starling.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDICATED AND DECREED that Defendants pay reasonable investigative fees and expenses to the Office of the Kansas Attorney General, pursuant to K.S.A. §50-632, in this case amounting to \$5,000.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDICATED AND DECREED that Defendants pay \$10,000.00 in civil penalties for each violation of the Kansas Consumer Protection Act alleged in Plaintiff's Petition, pursuant to K.S.A. §50-636, in this case amounting to \$50,000.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDICATED AND DECREED that Defendants pay \$10,000.00 in additional, enhanced civil penalties for each violation of the Kansas Consumer Protection Act alleged in Plaintiff's Petition that was committed against an individual deemed an "elder or disabled" victim pursuant to K.S.A. §50-676 and K.S.A. §50-677, in this case amounting to \$50,000.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDICATED AND DECREED that Defendants pay all court costs and all costs associated with distributing and executing on any restitution or judgment made by this Court

IT IS SO ORDERED.
