COMES NOW the plaintiff, State of Kansas, *ex rel.* Carla J. Stovall, Attorney General, by and through James J. Welch, Assistant Attorney General, and for her motion alleges and states as follows:


- 1) On or about December 18, 1998, the plaintiff brought suit against the defendant, National Credit Service for enforcement of a subpoena pursuant to K.S.A. §77-624(a) and K.S.A. §50-631(e).
- 2) To date, defendant has failed to respond to the plaintiff's petition or otherwise plead.
- 3) Pursuant to K.S.A. §50-631(e)(1) and (2), the court may grant injunctive relief restraining the sale or advertisement of any merchandise or issue any other relief as may be

required.

4) The basis for the complaint filed with the Attorney General's Consumer Protection Division is violations of the Kansas Consumer Protection Act, K.S.A. §50-623 *et seq.*


WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays that the court issue an order restraining the defendant from the sale or advertisement of any merchandise or services in the State of Kansas, and further relief as the court deems just and equitable.
