NOW on this 24th day of July, 1992, the above-entitled matter comes on regularly before the court for discovery conference. The plaintiff appears by and through Shelly Gasper, Assistant Attorney General. The defendant does not appear.

The court being fully and duly advised finds as follows:

- 1) Plaintiff duly notified defendant of the discovery conference by letter dated June 23, 1992. Counsel also spoke with defendant's attorney by phone within one week of the conference.
- 2) Because of defendant's failure to appear, defendant's answer is stricken from the record and plaintiff is granted default judgment.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that plaintiff shall have judgment against the defendant herein for the sums of \$64,100 restitution to 14 Kansas consumers as enumerated in Exhibit A to the petition; civil penalties in the amount of \$28,000 for violations of the Kansas Consumer Protection Act as set forth in the petition; and \$2,000 for reasonable investigative fees and expenses to the Attorney General; and costs herein.
