CHANGE OF STATUS FORM

Private detective must complete the change of status form if:

- You have been a licensed private detective as an employee of <u>one</u> private detective agency and wish to be a licensed private detective as an employee of <u>another</u> private detective agency.
- You have been a licensed private detective as an employee of a private detective agency and wish to be licensed as an independent private detective.
- You have been licensed as an independent private detective and wish to be a licensed private detective as an employee of a private detective agency.

• If you have been a licensed private detective as an employee of one private detective agency and wish to be a licensed private detective as an employee of another private detective agency:

Verification of Employment: You and you new private detective agency employer must *both* sign the Statement of Employment

• If you have been a licensed private detective as an employee of a private detective agency and wish to be licensed as an independent private detective:

Bond/Insurance/Deposit: You must provide verification of a corporate surety bond in the amount of \$100,000; a certificate of insurance showing general liability insurance which provides coverage in the amount of \$100,000 for bodily injury or property damage caused by negligence and errors or omissions; **or** verification of \$100,000 cash deposit with the State Treasurer.

• If you have been licensed as an independent private detective and wish to be a licensed private detective as an employee of a private detective agency:

Verification of Employment: You and you new private detective agency employer must *both* sign the Statement of Employment
